FROM THE EAST: Heading west on Interstate 80, take Exit 212-W (I-180 Williamsport) and continue to Exit 26, Basin Street. Continue onto Basin Street, through the first traffic light to the stop sign. Then, turn left onto East Fourth Street and right into the Krapf Gateway Center visitor lot.

FROM THE WEST: Heading east on Interstate 80, take Exit 178 (Lock Haven) and proceed along Route 220 North. Take Exit 27A, turning left onto Market Street. Turn right onto East Third Street. At the second traffic light, turn left onto Basin Street. At the stop sign, turn left onto East Fourth Street and right into the Krapf Gateway Center visitor lot.
